

Huntington School's Policy for Determining Homeroom Citizenship Grade

Every student will start the quarter off with an A+ in homeroom. Each infraction (i.e., tardy, no reading book, inappropriate behavior, late paperwork, etc.), will result in a lowered citizenship grade. For example:

Number of infractions:	Grade is lowered to:
1 infraction	A
2 infractions	A-
3 infractions	B+
4 infractions	B
5 infractions	B-
6 infractions	C+
7 infractions	C
8 infractions	C-
9 infractions	D+
10 infractions	D
11 infractions	D-
12 infractions	F

If a student is late to school they should report to their homeroom class (not the school office). Their tardy will be counted as one infraction. The teacher will not be concerned if it was excused or not excused, since the policy (i.e., the amount of infractions) provides for a student to be late on occasion (*like all human beings*). After a student receives 6 infractions parental contact will be made. If a student receives a D+ or lower on their citizenship grade, he/she cannot participate in certain school activities and will not be eligible for the academic scholarship program. Students will not be allowed to "make-up" infractions.

If a student reports to a homeroom after 8:15 AM they will be sent by their teacher to the office on a referral. Administration will determine if further disciplinary action is required.

This policy will renew each quarter.
